Motion by Lucarelli and supported by Strahan to add section (d) to New Business to add yearly insurance renewal and to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Strahan and supported by Seegert to approve the December 15th meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Goodin

Total monies in all accounts are \$4,347,333.67. Motion by Seegert and supported by Kolbe to accept Treasurers report. Roll call: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Pay Bills: Clerk Kolbe presented checks.

Motion by Goodin and supported by Strahan to pay checks #35106-35140 in the amount of \$68,490.80. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

New Business:

- a.) Resolution: Poverty Exemption Guidelines – Motion by Lucarelli and supported by Seegert to adopt the poverty exemption resolution as written presented by Assessor Haddix. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

- b.) Data Storage Center Moratorium – Motion by Seegert and supported by Strahan to adopt resolution number 2026-002 to impose a temporary moratorium to framework language for an ordinance to adopt in 12 months for Summerfield Township. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

- c.) Road Improvement Projects – Motion by Seegert and supported by Strahan to approve 2026 road Improvement estimates which includes:
 - Single Chip Seal on Valentine & McNeil Subdivision for a total cost of \$8,477.

 - 2” Aggregate Lift on Dunbar for 0.27 mile (Dixon to Dead End) for a total cost of \$5,342 with Summerfield Township funding \$2,671 contingent upon Dundee Township splitting cost share.

Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

- d.) Decker Insurance Renewal – Upon further discussion, Trustee Strahan insisted that the board seek quotes through different insurance companies for 2027. Motion by Seegert and supported by Kolbe to approve Decker Insurance Package for the year 2026 for a total of \$59,970.00. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.
